HISTORY & ACTIVITIES

STARRS began in 2020 after a group of retired military officers became concerned after watching a video by the **US Air Force Academy** football team promoting Black Lives Matter. The video kept repeating the term, "anti-racist", which is a primary component of Critical Race Theory (CRT).

Widely misunderstood, CRT is simply Marxism repackaged in new terms such as equity and is ultimately an ideological tool used to divide. Thus the Air Force Academy was advocating a controversial left-wing political agenda contrary to the norm of being apolitical.

Recognizing the seriousness of the development, the group approached the Academy leadership in an effort to remove the controversial video and to prevent the introduction of CRT into the academy's curriculum.

As the group continued to voice their concerns, word grew about them and they discovered to their dismay that there was a concerted effort to teach and implement aspects of CRT in not just the

military academies, but the US Armed Forces in general.

Their numbers continued to grow with more concerned General officers, service academy graduates, retired and active duty officers and enlisted, as well as civilians who knew

the dangers that the woke CRT/DEI push would have on the military in terms of readiness, recruitment and competency.

As a result, STARRS was formed in April 2021 as Stand Together Against Racism and Radicalism in the Services with the goal of eliminating the CRT/DEI influence in the military and academies.

With the initial focus on the Air Force Academy, then later to other service academies, the group has been active engaging with these schools holding them accountable for their actions regarding CRT and DEI.

STARRS has been educating and sounding the alarm about the divisive CRT ideology in the military. Our network writes

articles and letters, gives speeches, issues press releases, is interviewed in news media and podcasts, and we have our own podcast.

One member, an Air Force Academy graduate and officer, wrote a best-selling book, Irresistible Revolution: Marxism's Goal of Conquest & the Unmaking of the American Military which should be required reading for every cadet.

STARRS has filed 43 FOIA requests to find out what is really happening at the academies. For two of the FOIA's, Judicial Watch filed a suit that led to a federal court compelling the production of documents..

Being known as advocates for military service members and cadets, many of them came to STARRS asking for assistance with DOD's Covid-19 vaccination mandate. STARRS researched the issue and found DOD was illegally mandating an Emergency Use Authorized version of the vaccine. It also found the carte blanch denial of religious accommodation requests. STARRS was successful in contributing to the case for Congress rescinding the vaccine mandate in the FY 2023 National Defense Authorization Act. Now we are working with Congress on remedies for those victimized by the "radical" effort.



STARRS works with members of Congress, their staff and think tanks providing them information and guidance. The Chairman of the Board was a member of the National Independent of Military Service and Readiness Panel in Washington, DC and was influential in the final report which raised alarm of the growing politicization of the military.

This year our website was redesigned to be a one-stop place to track news stories concerning CRT/DEI/Woke in the military and academies, as well as the vax issue. We track comments on news articles and social media which provide useful insight and evidence from current and former military members and families concerning how the CRT/DEI/Woke agenda has hurt recruitment and retention.

We helped to eliminate the vax mandate in the military. Now we are on to our other goal: eliminate the woke CRT/DEI agenda seeking to destroy our military from within. This includes DEI indoctrination training and selecting and promoting people based on their identity or color of skin rather than their abilities and skill.

STARRS has received much pushback from those in the military and academies who don't like us shining a light on the hidden Marxist agenda taking place under the guise of diversity, equity and

inclusion. We admit we've made them angry, but that lets us know we are over the target and are effective in our targeting.

This Cold Cultural War will not be easily won because the enemy has infiltrated in so many areas. In many ways, this new covert face of Marxist ideology is far more dangerous than the overt Marxism we fought during the Cold War. But STARRS is there for the mission.

The core of STARRS has been retired military members—volunteers—who have worked tirelessly on these matters for long hours at no pay. While they could be enjoying their retirement, they are too concerned with the current state of the military they were so proud to serve in and their beloved service academies that they attended which made them who they are today—fighters for freedom.

They are also concerned with the direction of our nation and feel an obligation for the next generation, like their grand-children, that these grow up in a free country where they are selected for the quality of their character, not the color of their skin or gender.

To expand the work of STARRS, implement new initiatives, outreach and influence, we need to go to the next level by paying for full-time staff and experts.

This includes a President, researcher, public relations specialist, website/graphics/video expert, and a Congressional lobbyist.

Our current annual revenue and operating budget is \$100,000 which covers liability insurance, website, financial software, public relations, and educational handouts. Money mostly comes in through small (and occasionally larger) donations via our mailing list and website.

In order for STARRS to be able to have the capacity to do more, expand our reach, and be effective in working towards accomplishing our goal of eliminating CRT/DEI from the military and promoting meritocracy, we are seeking an initial annual budget of \$2 million. This would cover payroll for the full-time staff brought on, as well as provide funds for educational programs, outreach and operating expenses.

There is a growing awareness that the woke agenda is damaging the military and making our nation more vulnerable. **Now is the time to act.** STARRS is poised to make an even greater stand against the divisive agenda and promote the return to meritocracy.
